Statement by Rod Baltzer, Waste Control Specialists, President & CEO:

“Waste Control Specialists is delighted to inform its customers that – for a limited time – the state has significantly reduced its disposal surcharges for those customers currently disposing low level radioactive waste at the WCS facilities in Andrews County. For both in-compact and out of compact generators this will result in significant cost savings.

In-compact customers will see gross revenue fees cut in half and reduced from a total of 10.00 percent to 5.00 percent. Out-of-compact customers will see gross revenue fees reduced from 31.25 percent to 16.25 percent.

“These are significant reductions and are already resulting in dramatic cost-savings for our customers. This should encourage our customers to dispose of low level radioactive waste in our state-of-the-art facility in Andrews County and we are already seeing an uptick in scheduled disposal shipments.

“The new fee structure, which was passed by the Texas Legislature earlier this year and is now in effect, will remain in place through August 31, 2019. We don’t know what will happen after that, but we are pleased to have this 24-month window to offer these cost savings to our customers and encourage them to take advantage of this opportunity. Customers should contact WCS for any assistance needed to schedule their shipments or request import authorization as waste will be taken on a first-come, first-served basis.”
